ORDINANCE NO. 1035

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XV, OF THE CODE OF THE
CITY OF ST. JOHN, KANSAS REGARDING RECONNECTION FEES
FOR THE RECONNECTION OF UTILITIES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ST.
JOHN, KANSAS:

Amended Section 15-103 NOTICE; HEARING. (a) If a utility has not been paid on or before the due date as provided in this chapter, a delinquency and termination notice shall be issued by the city clerk within five days after the delinquency occurs and mailed to the customer at his or her last known address. A copy also shall be mailed to the occupant of the premises if the occupant and the customer are not the same person.

(b) The notice shall state:

(1) The amount due, plus delinquency charges;

(2) The reconnection fee due for reconnection of utilities if utilities are terminated;

(3) Notice that service will be terminated if the amount due is not paid within 10 days from the date of the notice unless the date on the notice to pay the charges due shall be on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, in which event such notice will give the consumer until the close of the next business day in which to pay the charges;

(4) Notice that the customer has the right to a hearing before the designated hearing officer;

(5) Notice that the request for a hearing must be in writing and filed with the city clerk no later than three days prior to the date for termination of service.

(c) Upon receipt of a request for hearing, the city clerk shall advise the customer of the date, time and place of the hearing which shall be held within three working days following receipt of the request.

Amended Section 15-215. RECONNECTION CHARGE. Whenever water service has been disconnected for nonpayment or fraudulent use, a charge for reconnection shall be added to the customer's bill and shall be paid prior to reconnection of water utilities. For a first-time reconnection as provided herein, the customer shall pay a reconnection fee of \$25.00. Any subsequent reconnection shall result in a fee increase of \$25.00 per reconnection not to exceed \$100.00. The city shall charge for restoring of water service outside of normal business hours a fee of \$25.00 in addition to the normal business hour reconnection fee as provided herein.

Amended Section 15-307. RECONNECTION CHARGE. Whenever electric service has been disconnected for nonpayment or fraudulent use, a charge for reconnection shall be added to the customer's bill and shall be paid prior to reconnection of electric utilities. For a first-time reconnection as provided herein, the customer shall pay a reconnection fee of \$25.00. Any subsequent reconnection shall result in a fee increase of \$25.00 per reconnection not to exceed \$100.00. The city shall charge for restoring of electric service outside of normal business hours a fee of \$25.00 in addition to the normal business hour reconnection fee as provided herein.

This ordinance shall be included in the Code of the City of St. John, Kansas and shall be effective upon adoption and publication in the official city newspaper.

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-04

This Resolution is made this 14th day of March, 2016, by the City Council of the City of St. John, Kansas.

WHEREAS, in 1991, the governing body of the City of St. John, Kansas, adopted a city code relative to the fees for connection to the city waterworks system in the City of St. John, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, in 15-207 of the city code, the governing body was granted the authority to change the fees from time to time by resolution of the governing body; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of St John, Kansas, believes it would be in the best interest of the City of St John, Kansas, to amend the fee for connection to the city waterworks system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of St John, Kansas, that effective March 16, 2016, the fees provided in the city code under 15-207 shall be changed as follows:

- A. Existing structures that desire to be connected onto the city water supply be charged a fee of \$200.00 for a ¾" tap and \$300.00 for a 1" tap including piping materials.
- B. Taps larger than ¾" shall be assessed at the time of installation. A reasonable fee shall be charged for taps larger than ¾" but shall not exceed \$
- C. New construction residence and commercial shall be exempt from the fee, with the exception of taps required to be larger than 1".
- D. Outside the city limits-The City of St. John may provide water service within a reasonable distance of such city limits. The customer shall be responsible for the line from residence to city's meter and pay a tap/connection fee of \$550.00

ONAGA — The day before Thanksgiving, Pam Budenbender was busy making sure everything was in place for the opening of Onaga Country Market the following Thursday.

Canned goods, paper products and other items lined shelves. Coolers and refrigerated cases stood waiting for dairy products, frozen foods, fresh produce and meats, while the finishing touches were being placed on the deli.

Onaga, a Pottawatomie County town of about 700, has been without a grocery store since an overnight fire on Dec. 2, 2010, destroyed Nider's Thriftway. Since then, most residents have had to drive at least 50 miles round-trip to St. Marys, Wamego or other area towns to stock up on groceries and supplies.

"I wanted to bring a little bit of the big city to Onaga," Budenbender said, describing why she chose to build a full-service grocery in the community. "We've been without a grocery store for a year, and I hope (area residents) will shop at home now."

Budenbender said she and her husband, Paul, who live in Shawnee, own a farm north of Onaga and spend many weekends there. Paul, who has relatives in the Onaga area, is co-owner of Epoxy Coating Specialists, a large flooring business in the Kansas City area.

"My retirement plan was to open a grocery store in Onaga," Budenbender said, adding her husband purchased several lots in Onaga a few years ago so she could someday realize that goal.

After the Thriftway was destroyed, other people talked about opening a grocery store in Onaga, but when none of those plans came to fruition, she decided to give it a try.

Budenbender, who has worked in retail but has no experience in operating a grocery store, said she teamed up with Morrill & Janes Bank to negotiate a deal with the city to build the grocery store. The Onaga City Council agreed to allocate \$375,000 toward the 7,500-square-foot building.

Budenbender also was able to get low-interest rural development loans with the help of the Pottawatomie County Rural Economic Development Corp. and NetWork Kansas. Representatives of Affiliated Foods Inc., a multistate grocery distributor, helped guide her through the process of ordering stock for the store.

"Everyone's been so wonderful and supportive," she said.

The store will employ four or five full-time and seven to 10 part-time workers.

Budenbender said she hopes the grocery store will draw into Onaga more people who also will shop at other businesses.

Onaga Mayor Gary Holthaus shares that hope.

"Without a store, your town disappears, and the valuation of property goes down," Holthaus said, adding residents have scattered like geese to area towns to buy groceries and other goods. "Sales tax leaves the town and the county."

Holthaus said Onaga residents are excited about the new grocery store. He said his wife plans to be there on opening day.

"It's been like kids at Christmas counting down the days," he said.
